

# Proclamation

## NAVAL SUBMARINE BASE KINGS BAY ADOPTION

**Whereas**, the Navy League of the United States is composed of Citizens in support of the Sea Services; and,

**Whereas**, the Camden – Kings Bay Council of the Navy League of the United States is composed of individuals and businesses located in close proximity to Naval Submarine Base Kings Bay; and,

**Whereas**, Naval Submarine Base Kings Bay and the Camden – Kings Bay Navy League Council have a long history of mutual support and shared objectives; and,

**Whereas**, the Navy League of the United States encourages Councils to adopt ships, stations, and other military units and facilities to focus the efforts of local Navy League members on a particular ship, station, military unit and facility and formalize a commitment of continuing support; and,

**Whereas**, the Camden – Kings Bay Council first adopted Naval Submarine Base Kings Bay on April 14, 2011, CAPT John O'Neill, Commanding Officer, and re-adopted the Command on October 9, 2014, CAPT James Jenks, Commanding Officer, and,

**Whereas**, the Camden – Kings Bay Navy League Council wishes to renew our adoption of Naval Submarine Base Kings Bay, reaffirm our commitment to the Officers, Crew and subordinate commands on the Base, and restate our pledge to do everything in our power to promote rapport between our Council and Naval Submarine Base Kings Bay.
