NAVAL SUBMARINE BASE KINGS BAY ADOPTION

Whereas, the Camden – Kings Bay Council of the Navy League of the United States is composed of individuals and businesses located in close proximity to Naval Submarine Base Kings Bay; and,

Whereas, Naval Submarine Base Kings Bay and the Camden – Kings Bay Navy League Council have a long history of mutual support and shared objectives; and,

Whereas, the Camden – Kings Bay Navy League Council wishes to formalize our relationship with Naval Submarine Base Kings Bay, demonstrate our commitment to the Officers, Crew and subordinate commands on the Base, and pledge to do everything in our power to promote rapport between our Council and Naval Submarine Base Kings Bay; and,
